Ken (Elizabeth Aldrich's brother) & Carmen will talk about their work in Almazan, Soria in Northern Spain, with pictures. 45 years ago, Ken was commended as a missionary to Spain and at the same time Carmen was commended from a Spanish assembly to the same work, and they were soon married! They worked in Madrid for many years, then moved to Fuerteventura in the Canary Islands, until last year when they were called to move to their present place of work. Their work has always centred on caring for individuals, and nurturing Christians, in the context of building up the local church.
